

Global Studies Requirement

All students following a 1999-2000 or later catalog must complete an approved Global Studies course. The Global Studies course will cover content involving cultures and traditions of Asia, the Middle East, Africa, Latin America or Indigenous Peoples of the World.

The University Curriculum Committees charged with the approval of such courses, which must meet the following criteria: (a) the course focuses primarily upon facets of specific cultures from these regions or these cultures in general (a minimum of 75% of the course content must deal directly with the culture(s) from these regions; (b) exploration of the culture(s) is developed in a comparative perspective which helps the student understand and appreciate differences between culture(s) under consideration and American culture; and (c) the course includes exposure to primary writings and artifacts from the culture.

Native students (freshmen) must complete the requirement through approved courses in the Outer Core of the General Education Program. Transfer students must meet the requirement through approved courses in the Illinois State University's General Education program or through appropriately articulated transfer courses.
