Job Summary

Responsibilities:

Tasks would include; Evaluate renewal and new business with oversight from direct report and/or experienced Business Solutions Underwriters. Assist with the structure and negotiation of appropriate terms and conditions. Evaluate and negotiate contract wording. Evaluate underwriting documents including Engineering reports and Statement of Values.

The Underwriting Associate Intern would also work on various underwriting projects and studies. Examples include a portfolio analysis of high hazard flood exposure, whereby the Intern would use public data (flood maps) along with engineering reports to assess the exposure and any mitigation factors (levy walls etc).

The Underwriting Associate Intern would also assist in compiling information for a Property Working Group report that serves a critical role in SCOR's ERM efforts.

Additionally, you will be working on a project that will be due at the end of your assignment. This summer internship will be based in our New York office.
