It is the parent company of Ameren Illinois, based in Collinsville, Ill., Ameren Missouri, based in St. Louis, and Ameren Transmission Company, also based in St. Louis.</p>

Ameren Illinois delivers electricity to 1.2 million customers and gas to more than 800,000 customers in more than 1,200 communities with a service territory spanning 43,700 square miles. Ameren Illinois' complex delivery system includes about 4,500 miles of electric transmission lines and 46,000 miles of distribution lines.

Founded in 1902, Union Electric - now known as Ameren Missouri - is the state's largest electric utility. Ameren Missouri generates 10,200 megawatts of electricity, provides electric service to approximately 1.2 million customers and gas service to 100,000 customers in 63 counties and more than 500 towns. More than half (53 percent) of Ameren Missouri's electric customers are located in St. Louis and St. Louis County.

Ameren Transmission Company was formed in July 2010 and is dedicated to electric transmission infrastructure investment and expanding Ameren's transmission system.

Overall, Ameren employs more than 8500 personnel and powers the quality of life for 2.4 million electric customers and more than 900,000 natural gas customers across a 64,000-square-mile area.
